"Ultra Scoop" Loads Semi-Trailers from Flat Storage Grain Piles in 3 Minutes

George, IA April 6, 2007 - Record harvests in past years means grain stored in flat piles is a common site across North America. To meet the demand for faster and better ways to load this grain once the need occurs, Sudenga Industries of George, IA, introduces the new 20,000 bushel per hour Ultra Scoop, tractor mounted flat pile loader.

Highlights of the new Ultra Scoop include:

- Loads grain at up to 20,000 bushels per hour, filling most semi-trailers in just three minutes.
- No need to purchase specialized machinery for operation. A 150 HP or larger tractor is the only other equipment needed. The operator faces the discharge of the Ultra Scoop ensuring better attention to truck driver and trailer fill status.
- An available hydraulically actuated spout directs grain to minimize the number of times the trailer must reposition for complete fill.
- The Ultra Scoop features heavy commercial components throughout for long life and minimal maintenance. Gearboxes and bearings are industrial duty.
- A 40 foot long, 22" x 27" galvanized drag chain conveyor with abrasion resistant steel liners and 42,000 pound tensile strength chain is standard.
- 16-inch diameter by 16-foot long horizontal feeder auger ensures maximum fill rate for the conveyor. Six feet of the intake auger is detachable for convenient transport.
- The Ultra Scoop Transport features castor wheels for maneuverability. The unit is self-supporting when not connected to the tractor. The operator backs the tractor into position, connects the three-point and hydraulics and the Ultra Scoop is ready for use.
- An optional "grain thrower" is available which allows the Ultra Scoop to be used for piling of grain.
